



## **Metric Criss Cross Card**

### **Paper Sizes:**

- Two - 10.5 cm x 29.7 cm cardstock
- One - 10.5 cm x 14.8 cm patterned paper, cut in half diagonally.
- One - 13.5 x 9.5 coordinating cardstock (Note card)
- One - 13 cm x 9 cm neutral cardstock
- One- 2.5 cm x 13.5 cm patterned paper strip

### **Supplies:**

- Metric Scor-Pal®
- Scor-Tape™
- Adhesive of choice
- Scor-Mat™ (metric coming soon)
- Craft knife
- Stamps and ink
- Punches
- Ribbon

### **Step 1**

Align 29.7 cm side of cardstock to top fence, left side and score at the ♥ symbol. Repeat on second piece of cardstock.



## **Step 2**

Remove triangular section on opposing sides, as illustrated in photo. From scored center line to bottom right corner on one piece and from scored center line to bottom left corner on the second piece.



## **Step 3**

Pre-fold scores. Place 2 strips of Scor-Tape™ on back panel; remove backing and adhere sections together.



## **Step 4**

Place a strip of Scor-Tape™ along the bottom edge of the inside section, remove backing and adhere right triangular panel.



### **Steps 5 – 6**

After adhering triangle, adhere one of the precut patterned paper triangles. Next, place a strip of Scor-Tape™ along the bottom edge, to just shy of the fold on the right. Remove paper backing.



### **Step 7**

Adhere left triangular section to base. Adhere second precut patterned paper triangle



### **Step 8**

Assemble **Notecard** by adhering neutral cardstock layer to coordinating mat. Stamp images on note card, if desired. Add a punched tab, ribbon, hardware pull, etc. for easy removal of notecard. Embellish outside of Criss Cross card with ribbon, punches, and stamped images, if desired.
