



## **Metric Flap Fold**

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Adapted from tutorial by Rose Anne Reynolds

### **Paper Sizes:**

- One – 9 cm x 28 cm piece of cardstock
- One – 8.5 cm x 10.5 cm piece of patterned paper
- One – 8.5 cm x 11 cm piece of cardstock
- One – 8 cm x 10.5 cm neutral piece of cardstock
- One – focal piece for front of card

### **Supplies:**

- Metric Scor-Pal®
- Punches and/or die cut machine
- Stamps and ink
- Magnetic Clasp

### **Step 1**

Align the 28 cm side of the cardstock to the top fence, left side, and score at 11 cm.



## **Step 2**

Move cardstock to the 5mm mark and score at 23 cm. Note the positioning of the left side of paper.



## **Step 3**

Trim a half circle using a Coluzzle or circle temple on the shorter (11cm) scored end of the cardstock. Measure up 1 cm from the 11 cm scored line and make a light pencil line on each side of the cardstock. Align your cutting pattern to these marks and trim half circle. Discard scrap.



## **Step 4**

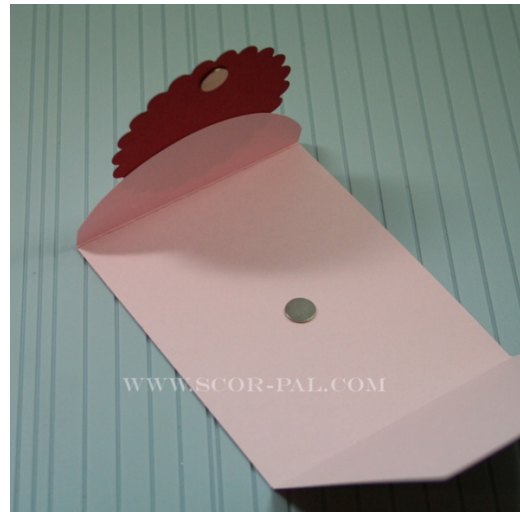
Pre-fold scores.



**Step 5** Adhere 8.5 cm x 10.5 cm piece of patterned paper to front panel. Adhere finished focal panel to flap. Add sentiment, if desired.

## **Step 6 and 7**

Attach magnetic clasp to underside of focal piece and to the inside the base of the card. The easiest way to accomplish this is to have the + and – stuck together when adhering to the back side of the focal piece. After adhering to the focal piece, remove the liner from the other clasp, leaving it attached to its sister magnet, and close the focal piece to the base. This will transfer the magnet to the appropriate place on the card base.



### **Step 8**

Adhere matted neutral cardstock to the base to cover the magnet. Your personalized sentiment may be added prior to adhering cardstock to base. Sample was left blank.
