



Metric It's a Wrap

Paper Size:

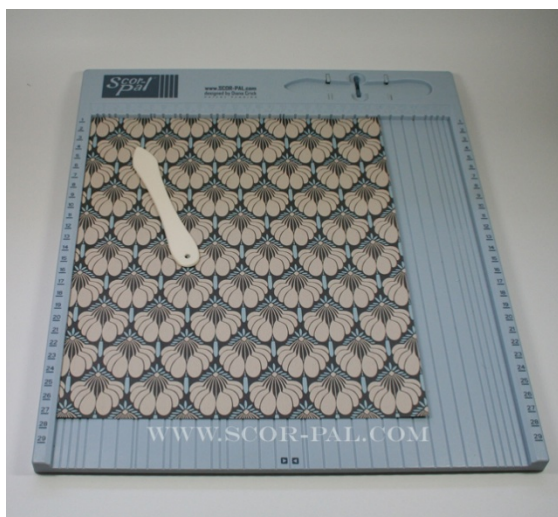
- One – 24 cm x 27 cm patterned paper or cardstock

Supplies:

- Metric Scor-Pal®
- Scor-Mat™ (metric coming soon)
- Scor-Tape™ or double sided adhesive
- Craft knife
- Metal Edged ruler
- Corner Rounder
- Ribbon
- Tag supplies: stamp, ink, cardstock, punches and cording

Step 1

Align the 24 cm side at the top fence, left side, and score at 3 cm, 7 cm, 17 cm and 21 cm.



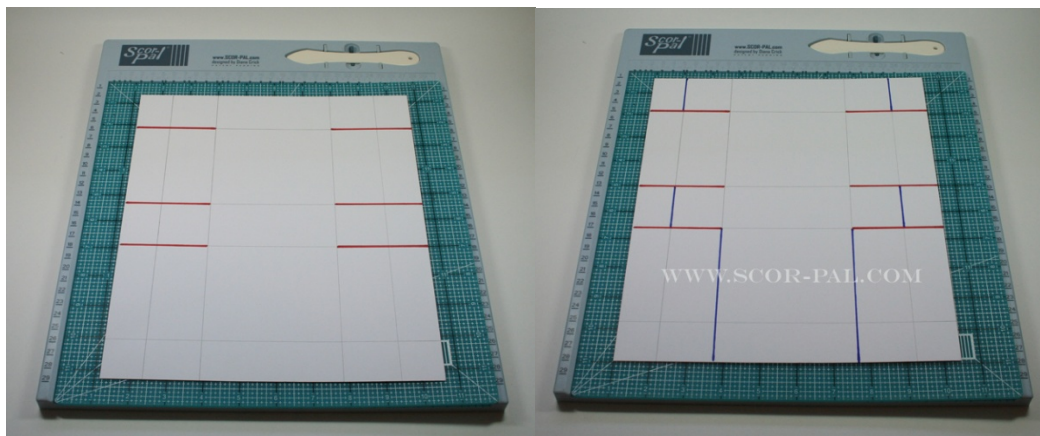
Step 2

Rotate $\frac{1}{4}$ turn and align the 27 cm at the top fence, left side, and score at 4 cm, 12 cm, 16 cm and 24 cm.



Step 3

For illustration purposes the score lines are drawn in pencil on white cardstock. Cut lines are indicated by marker. Ensure that the 4 cm side is at the top and cut on the orange lines. Next, cut on the blue lines and remove trimmings.



Step 3 continued

After all the cuts are made this should be your end result.

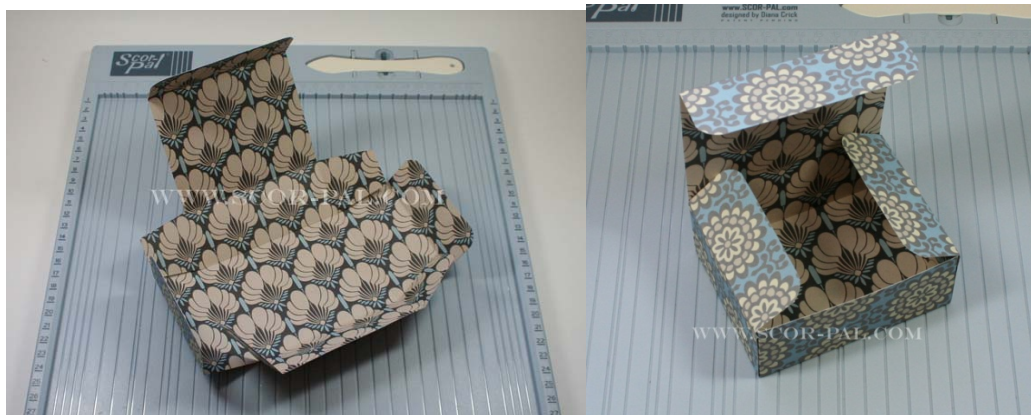


Step 4

Corner round side flaps and end flap. Notch 4 tabs. Attach Scor-Tape™ to tabs.

Step 5

Pre-fold all scores and assemble box by adhering tabs to inside. Fold side flaps to inside, but do not flatten down or adhere; these flaps keep the contents of the box from showing.



Step 6

Fill box with candy treats, a gift card, jewelry, etc. and tie with a beautiful satin bow!

- Tip: line box with parchment paper or wax paper before filling with treats to keep treat residue off of the paper.
- Alternative closures for front flap: magnetic clasps, Velcro® or a button closure.
