



Metric Triangular Tri-Fold

Idea- Cambria Turnbow

Paper Sizes:

- One - 9 cm x 27 cm piece of cardstock
- One - 8.5 cm square piece of patterned paper
- One - 8.5 cm square piece of cardstock
- One - 8 cm piece of neutral cardstock
- One - focal image of your choice

Supplies:

- Metric Scor-Pal®
- Scor-Tape™ or double sided adhesive
- Scor-Mat™ (metric coming soon)
- Craft Knife
- Metal edged ruler
- Ribbon, approx. 60 cm. Trim excess when finished.
- Stamps and ink

Step 1

Align the 27 cm side of cardstock to the top fence, left side and score at 9 cm and 18 cm.



Step 2

Turn cardstock over. Align upper left corner and the bottom of the first scored line on any score line. Ensure that the points are lined up on the same score line; score, this creates a diagonal score.



Step 3

Repeat diagonal score on the right panel. Align bottom right corner and upper left of the second score line on any score line. Ensure that the points are lined up on the same score line; score, this creates your second diagonal score. Both lines go in the same direction.



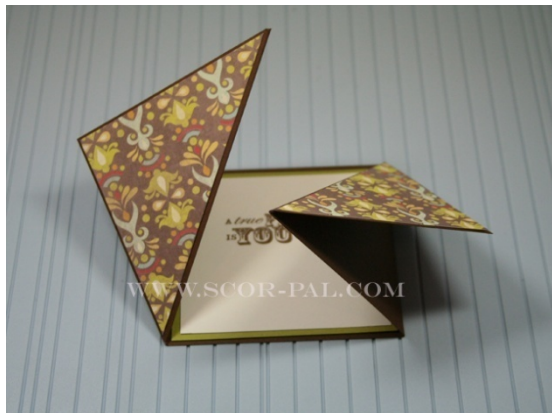
Step 4

Cut 8.5 cm square of patterned paper in half diagonally.



Step 5 - 7

Pre-fold all scores, attached patterned paper triangles to front panels, and adhere matted sentiment panel inside.



Step 8

Turn card over, place Scor-Tape™ horizontally at the half way point on the back of the card.



Step 9

Turn over so the front of the card is facing up and place a small piece of Scor-Tape™ horizontally at the half way point of the left triangle. Remove Scor-Tape™ backing and adhere ribbon.



Step 10

Glue focal image to card front. Ensure focal panel is adhered to left triangular section only so it will still open. Tie card together with a bow on the right side. Trim excess ribbon, if necessary.
