Metric Joy –Fold Card

Step 1

Create card base by scoring the A4 sized cardstock at the asterisk to create an A5 sized card. Set score, and set aside.



Step 2 and 3

With the opposite side of the patterned paper showing, align paper to right fence and score at the heart symbol. Tear or trim 2.5 cm off of the left side of the scored piece; be sure you are removing from the smaller portion of the scored paper. Set score and set aside.





Step 4

Score red 22cm x 6.5cm strip at 12cm. Set aside.



Step 5

Stamp image panels as desired and adhere to blue mats. Set an eyelet on the left side of the larger panel, as shown. Eyelet is centered at 3cm down left side. Distress edges of blue mat. Thread ribbon through eyelet hole.



Step 6

Adhere completed image panels to red strip, as shown. Top (larger) image is adhered to red panel with dimensional foam; bottom (smaller) image is adhered directly to red panel with adhesive.



Step 7 and 8

On the reverse side of the patterned paper, perpendicular to the scored and folded section, adhere a small strip of Scor-Tape at the half way point. Remove backing and secure ribbon.



Step 9

Adhere patterned paper to card base with adhesive ensure that the flap on the left side.



Step 10

To finish card, adhere completed folding image panel to card front. Center hinged portion along the right side of the card and adhere only the bottom red panel to the patterned paper. Tie ribbon lengths together in a bow.
