

Metric Box with 4 Drawers

Paper Sizes:

- 2 pieces: 10,5 cm x 10,5 cm of cardboard
- 4 pieces: 10,7 cm x 10,7 cm of pink Bazzill cardstock
- 4 pieces: 6 cm x 12 cm of white Bazzill cardstock
- 4 pieces: 6,6 cm x 9 cm of white Bazzill cardstock
- 3 pieces: 9,9 cm x 9,9 cm of patterned paper
- 1 piece: 10,3 cm x 20,6 cm white Bazzill cardstock

Supplies:

- Metric Scor-Pal®
- Craft knife
- Stamps and Distress Reinkers
- TimHoltz Hitch Fasteners
- Spellbinders Nesting Petite Oval Large
- Ribbon
- Lace
- Pearls
- Flowers
- 3D foam

Step 1

Apply Scor-Tape™ or adhesive to the cardboards, and paste cardstock on both sides of the cardboards.



Step 2

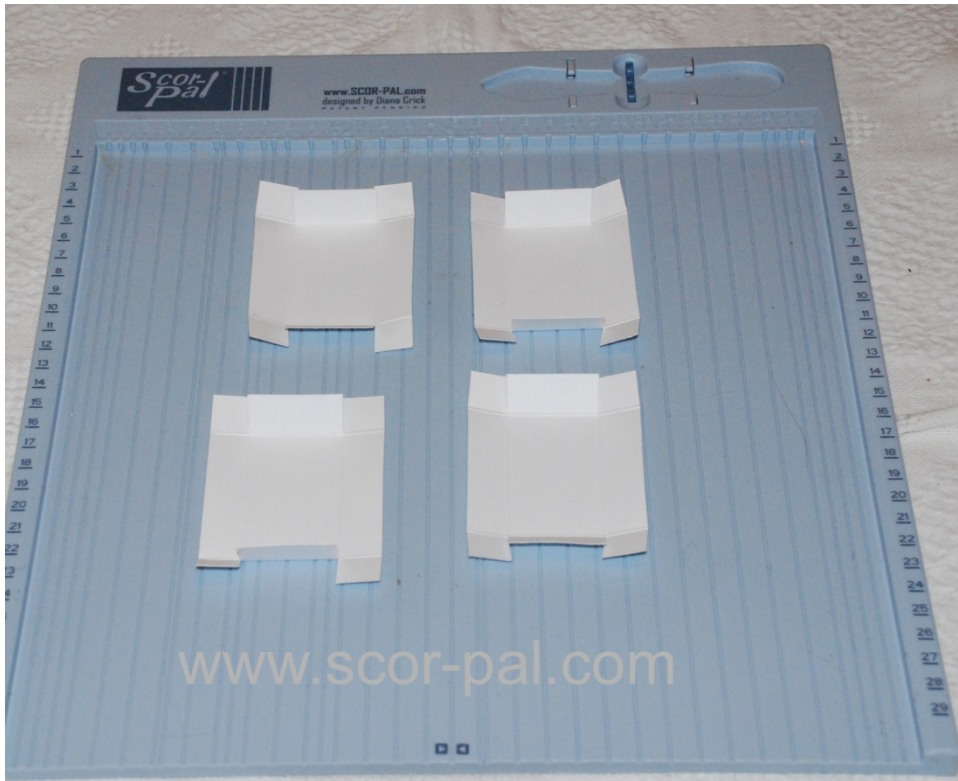
The cardstock for each drawer is 6,6 cm (width) x 9 cm (length):

- Scor at 1,6 cm and 5 cm (width) (shown as blue lines on the picture below)
- Scor at 1,6 cm and 7,4 cm (length) (shown as blue lines on the picture below)



Step 3

Prefold all scores and adhere flaps to create box form.
Attach Scor-Tape™ or adhesive to each flap.



Step 4

Decorate the Drawers with patterned paper and Hitch Fasteners as shown below.



Step 5

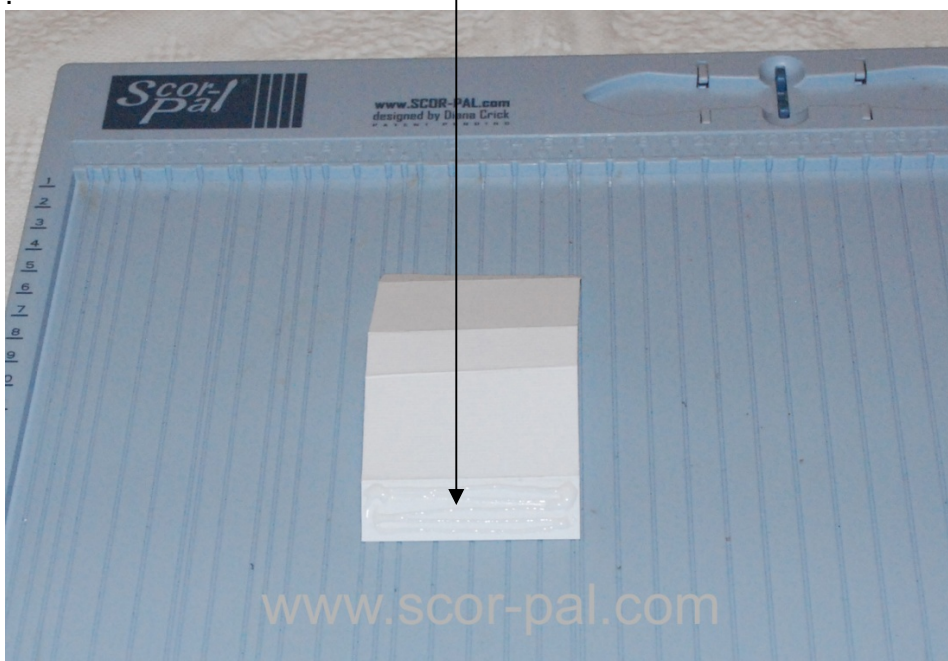
The cardstock around the drawers are 6 cm (width) x 12 cm (length):

- Scor at 1,7 cm, 5,2 cm, 6,9 cm and 10,4 cm (shown as blue lines on the picture below)



Step 6

Attach Scor-Tape™ or adhesive here:



Step 7

The drawers are finished.



Step 8

Assemble the drawers on the bottom of the box.



Step 9

Assemble the lid on top of the drawers, and the box is almost done...



Step 10

Make a card on the top of the box, and decorate the box as desired.
