



Metric Upright “Z” Fold

Paper Sizes:

- One 10.5 cm x 29.7 cm piece of black cardstock
- One 10.5 cm x 14.7 cm piece of patterned paper
- One 8 cm x 13 cm piece of green cardstock
- One 7 cm x 11 cm piece of black cardstock
- One 6.5 x 10.5 cm piece of vanilla cardstock

Supplies:

- Metric Scor-Pal©
- Scor-Tape™ or adhesive
- Scalloped border punch or similar decorative edge punch
- Label punch or similar punch
- Button and mini brads
- Ribbon and thread
- Dimensional foam

Step 1

Align the 29.7 cm side of cardstock to the top fence, left side, and score at the ♥ symbol.



Step 2

Turn cardstock over, align the 29.7 side at the top fence, left side, and score at the + symbol.



Step 3

Fold card into a "Z." Fold the ♥ scored line with the mountain facing inside, valley on the back. Fold the + scored line on the valley with the mountain to the underside of the card. This will create an accordion fold. Set scores with your Scor-Tool™.



Step 4

Punch a circle from a scrap of cardstock (example is imperial 1-3/8") and adhere Scor-Tape to top half of back side.



Step 5

Adhere patterned paper to back panel. Using your Metric Scor-Pal © as a ruler, align the top of the Z card to the top fence, left side, and adhere punched circle at the midway point at the + symbol, ensure that the adhesive side is at the top of the card.



Step 6

Scallop border punch, or similar decorative edge punch, the bottom short edge of the 8 cm x 13 cm piece of green cardstock. Adhere to front of card, ensure that adhesive is just on the bottom portion of green panel.

Stamp and embellish the 6.5 x 10.5 cm vanilla layer and mat with the 7 cm x 11 cm black layer. Adhere to green panel with dimensional foam. Slide under embellished circle.
