



One Sheet Box

Original tutorial by Beate Johns

Adapted to the newer Scor-Pal by Valerie Stangle

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Paper Sizes:

- One 8-1/2" x 11" piece of cardstock or patterned paper
- One 4" square coordinating cardstock

Supplies

- Scor-Pal®
- Scor-Mat™
- Scor-Tape™
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Circle Die or Circle Cutting System
- Embellishments

Step 1

Align the 8-1/2" side to the top fence, left side, and score at 2-1/2" and 6".



Step 2

Rotate ¼ turn and align the 11" side to the top fence, left side, and score at 4-1/2" and 6-1/2".



Step 3

Insert Scor-Mat into Scor-Pal. Turn paper over. Along each long side make pencil marks at 2" and 11" – 4 marks total.



Step 4

Diagonally score from each pencil mark to where the score lines intersect. Example uses the 6" score channel.

Tip: Use a ruler as a guide to ensure the pencil mark and intersecting point are along the same score line.



Step 5

Pre-fold all scores. Adhere 2 pieces of Scor-Tape, as shown, if desired. Fold and assemble bag securing with Scor-Tape. Once bag is assembled, gently press bag sides inward.



Step 6

Align the 4" square cardstock to the top fence, left side, and score at 2".



Step 7

Cut a 3-1/2" diameter circle using a die or circle cutting system. Sample was embossed prior to cutting circle. Adhere Scor-Tape to inside, as shown.



Option: if another shape is desired for lid closure, the width of the bag is 3-1/2" wide. Determine the depth for the lid and score in the middle. Example: 3-1/2" x 4" cardstock, align the 4" side to the top fence, left side, and score at 2", leaves a lid that is 3-1/2" x 2" when adhered to the bag.

Step 8

Adhere closure to back of bag. Embellish as desired. Secure bag closed with ribbons, magnets, Velcro, etc.
