Paper Size:

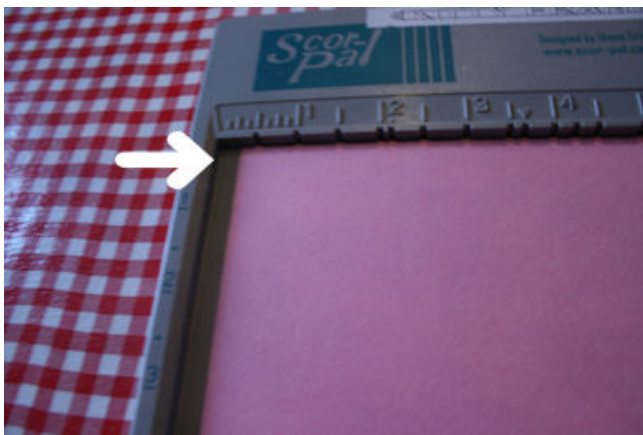
- One 8" x 11-1/2" piece of cardstock or patterned paper

Supplies:

- Scor-Pal®
- Scor-Mat™
- Nestabilities Circle Die™, Circle Cutting System or Circular shape (plate, saucer, etc.)
- Pencil
- Craft knife
- Metal Edged ruler
- Scissors
- Hand held hole punch
- Ribbon, stamps, ink, stickers, punches, etc. to embellish as desired.

Step 1

Align the 11-1/2" side to the top fence, left side, at the 1/4" mark and score at 4" and 8".



Step 2

Rotate paper $\frac{1}{4}$ turn and align the 8" side to the top fence, left side, and score at 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 5- $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



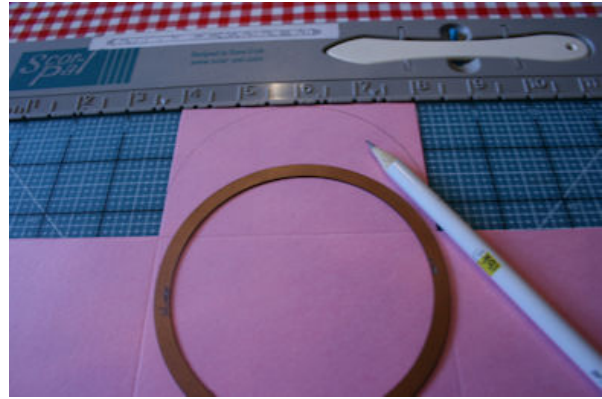
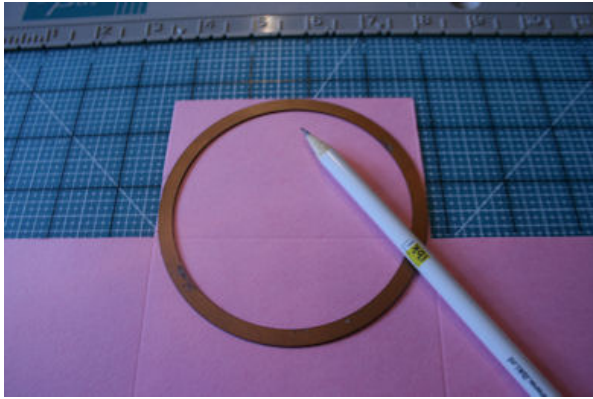
Step 3

Cut to where the score lines intersect using a craft knife and metal edged ruler (not shown) or scissors.



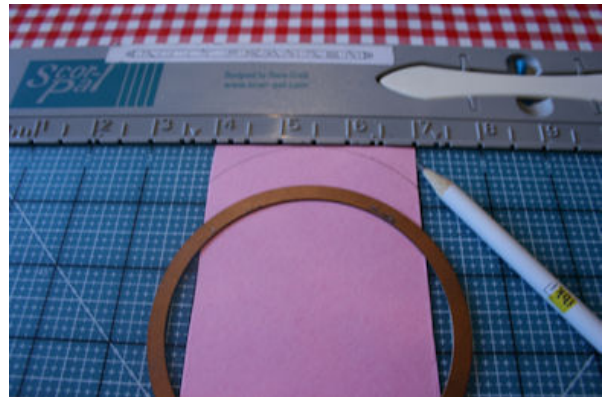
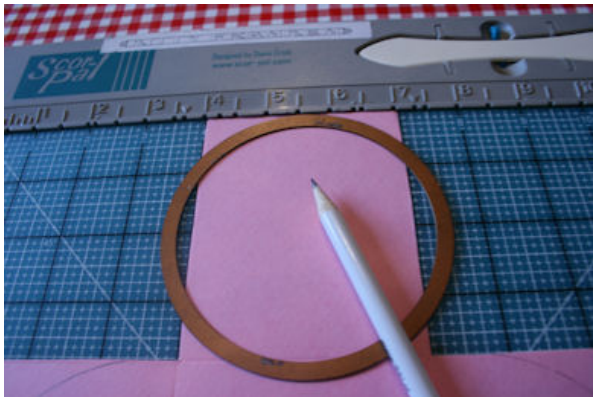
Step 4

On the two shorter flaps trace around the perimeter of a Nestabilities circle die or similar circle shape with a pencil. Refer to picture below for the placement of the circle shape.



Step 5

On remaining two opposing flaps trace around your circle die or circle shape. Refer to the picture below for placement of the circle shape.



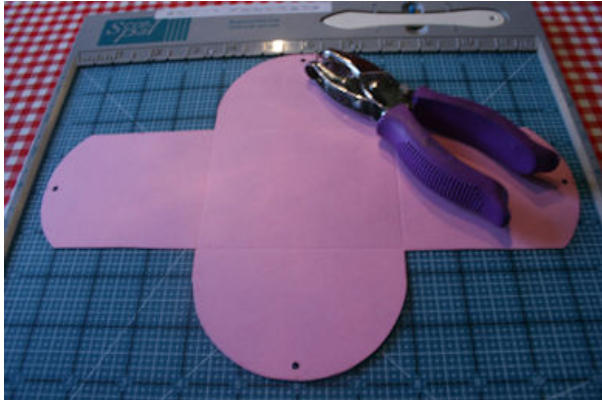
Step 6

Trim flaps with scissors.



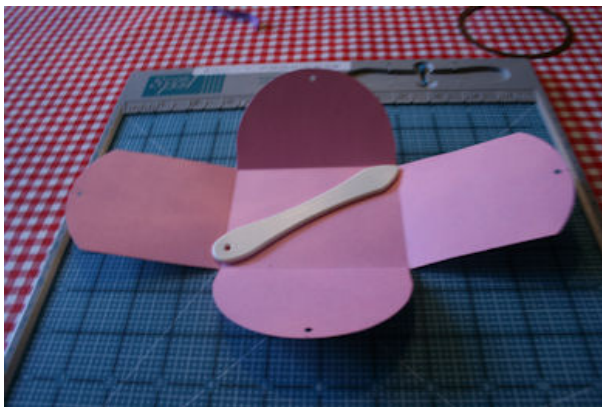
Step 7

Punch holes in the center top of each flap with a hand held hole punch.



Step 8

Pre-fold all scores.



Step 9

Embellish as desired. To close, tie smaller flaps together with ribbon first, followed by larger flaps.
