



Metric Jump Card
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Paper Sizes:

- One 24 cm x 15 cm for base card
- Coordinating layers for focal point, if desired; dimensions will vary.

Supplies:

- Metric Scor-Pal™
- Metric Scor-Mat
- Pencil
- Ruler
- Stamps, stickers, inks, embellishments, as desired.

Step 1

Place Metric Scor-Mat into Metric Scor-Pal. Align the 15 cm side of cardstock to the top fence, left side, and make a pencil mark at 7,5 cm.



Step 2

Rotate left $\frac{1}{4}$ turn and align the 24 cm side of cardstock to the top fence, left side, and make a pencil mark at 6 cm on both the top and bottom edge of cardstock.



Step 3

Remove mat. Score diagonally from the 7,5 cm mark to the 6 cm pencil mark. Ensure pencil marks are lined up on the same scoring groove before scoring. Repeat on other side.

Tip: Prior to scoring, use a ruler to ensure pencil marks are lined up correctly. Remove ruler before final scoring.



Step 4

Align the 24 cm side to the top fence, left side, and score at 12 cm.



Step 5

Turn cardstock over by flipping top to bottom, *not* side to side. Align the 24 cm side to the top fence, left side, and score at 18 cm.



Step 6

Score diagonally from one edge of the 6 cm score line to the opposite edge 18 cm score line. Ensure score is lined up in the same groove before scoring. Repeat on other side.



Step 7

Pre-fold all scores.



Step 8

Attach Scor-Tape on bottom portion, as shown below. Remove liner and adhere to base.



Step 9

Turn cardstock over and attach Scor-Tape to flaps. Remove liner and adhere flaps to back.



Decorate image panel as desired with stickers, stamps, ink, embellishments, etc.
